## Is It Time To Replace Your Furnace?

Keeping your home warm and comfortable is the sole function of your furnace, but is your home heating system doing its job or is it time for a replacement?

evaluate your home heating system to see how efficiently it operates. In the long run, purchasing a new and more energy efficient system can cost less than keeping an older and less energy-efficient

system. New ultra-high-efficiency furnaces, such as the Comfortmaker SoftSound™ 90 series, can wring more than 90% of the heat out of each cubic foot of natural gas.

### 2. Are some rooms too cold and others too warm?

Most furnaces have one speed – full blast, even on days when you need just a little heat. This prevents the furnace from operating long enough to spread heat evenly through your home. Some newer furnaces, like the Comfortmaker SoftSound IIS 90, use a two-stage ignition system that operates on a lower heating output setting most of the time, then powers up to full capacity when the weather turns really cold. The result is smoother, more even heating throughout your home.

### 3. How good is your indoor air quality?

Do you have an air cleaner or humidifier? Excess dust and allergens in the home can lead to poor indoor air quality. Constantly running the blower allows electronic air cleaners to filter indoor air continuously, but it is often costly for homes with older furnaces. Variable-speed furnaces, such as the Comfortmaker SoftSound VS 90, use high-efficiency blower motors to make it affordable to run the circulating blower full time.

### 4. Is your furnace too noisy?

If you have to turn up the volume on your TV when your furnace turns on, then you probably need a quieter furnace. Comfortmaker SoftSound VS 80 and VS 90 furnaces offer special quiet-operating features, including an electronically controlled variable-speed blower and a two-stage burner that operates at a quieter low-fire stage except when your home needs a heating boost.

If your home heating system isn't providing you with the comfort you want, contact a home heating contractor to make repairs or help you choose and install a new furnace. Finding the right system to fit your home can be a difficult decision, but there is a Comfortmaker air conditioner, furnace and heat pump to meet the needs of every home.

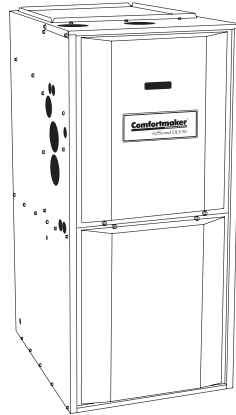
